

Middle School Goal Chart Instructions



Supplies*:

- Two tri-fold boards
- Gray duct tape
- Gray, black, and white paint
- Utility knife
- Scissors
- Hot glue gun
- Cardboard

Directions:

1. Lay two tri-fold boards open and flat on the floor, one above the other so that the 4'-wide sides are flush.
2. Tape the two boards together to create an 8' x 4' panel.
3. Paint the back of the combined boards (the brown side) alternating shades of gray to give it the look of a stone jail wall.
4. Paint a black square window in the top board.
5. Apply gray duct tape vertically on the black window to create the jail cell bars.
6. Cut out a 2' x 1' piece of cardboard to make the sign. Paint the cardboard. Write the message on the painted sign with white or gray paint. Trim the dry sign with gray Duct tape.
7. Attach the sign to the top of the jail with hot glue.
8. Prop up the jail and fold back the side panels at 90 degrees so the cell is able to stand on its own.
9. Print and cut out the "Wanted" posters on pages 2-6. Attach them to the cell front starting with the lowest amount on the bottom, going up to "1000 Books Sold" on the top.
10. Print and cut out the red CAPTURED labels on pages 7-8. As you meet your goals, tape the red CAPTURED labels on the corresponding poster.

*Remember, these are only suggestions. This project should be fun and creative, so use supplies you have on hand for substitutions.
