Western Wagon Wheel Instructions



Supplies*:

- Hula hoop
- Cardboard
- Brown duct tape
- Utility knife
- Hot glue gun
- Scissors

Directions:



1. Cover the entire hula hoop in brown duct tape.




2. Cut four 1" strips of cardboard the diameter of the hula hoop. Cover the strips with brown duct tape. (For safety purposes, we recommend wearing leather gloves when using the utility knife. Never leave the utility knife where children can pick it up.)




3. Apply hot glue to the ends of the strips. Flip the strips upside down and attach the strips to the hula hoop.

^{*}Remember, these are only suggestions. This project should be fun and creative, so use supplies you have on hand for substitutions.



4. Flip the whole wheel over.



5. Cut out an 8" circle from cardboard.



6. Cover the circle with duct tape.
Attach the circle to the center of the wheel with hot glue.
