What you need


- Brown felt
- Ribbon
- Craft glue
- Chinese sayings
- Sweet treats



What to do



1. Trace a 10-cm-diameter circle onto felt using a lead pencil. Cut it out.



2. Attach a 20-cm piece of ribbon across the centre of the circle using craft glue. Let this dry overnight.



3. Tie a bow using the two ends of the ribbon, so that the ribbon sits on the outside of the felt.



4. Gently push the sides down over the ribbon to form the fortune cookie.



5. Place a Chinese saying inside the fortune cookie, along with a sweet treat.

Teachers:

Ribbon should be about 1 cm in diameter to ensure the fortune cookie 'sits' correctly. You can download a large number of Chinese sayings from www.scholastic.com/toolkit then click on the 'What's New' tab for Issue 7.
