


Trace and Paint Elephant

- Enlarge the elephant design on the next page onto A3 art paper.
- Photocopy one elephant for every child in the class.
- Instruct children to trace over the patterns on the elephant's blanket using wax crayons or oil pastels.
- Ask students to colour-in the white of the eye and the toenails of the elephant using white wax crayon or oil pastel.
- Allow students to paint/sponge the entire surface of the elephant with grey paint. The wax crayon / oil pastels should resist the paint and show through.
- Provide students with sequins to glue onto the blanket once the elephant is dry.
- Once cut out, these elephants can create a string of marching elephants around your classroom walls!
