## Make a geyser





- A tube of mints
- A 2 litre bottle of diet soda
- Piece of paper made into a tube shape

## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- Open the bottle of soda, and place the bottle on the ground so that it will not tip over.
- 2. Make sure everyone is standing far enough away from the bottle!
- 3. Place the paper tube into the bottle.
- 4. Unwrap the mints and drop about half a packet into the bottle of soda at the same time.
- 5. Stand clear and get ready to watch the 'geyser' erupt!

NOTE: Please ensure you have enough space for this activity—a school field is ideal.

You can use regular soda for this activity, but diet soda is less sticky to clean up afterwards.
