Landscape Collage

Materials:

- 12cm x 18cm construction paper (black, blue, yellow, red, green)
- Scissors
- Glue

Procedure:

Take a piece of black construction paper. Draw a skyline from one side to the other. It could be a mountain skyline, a desert skyline, or an island/ocean skyline. Cut on this line so you have a silhouette of the landscape.



 Place either half of your paper on another colour of construction paper. You could use green, blue, yellow, orange—virtually any other colour depending on the effect you want to achieve.



- 3. Cut out other shapes to represent windows in buildings, leaves on trees, waves, stars, or even the blazing sun.
- 4. When you have all the shapes cut out you are ready to glue them down. Think about which shapes should be behind others. Arrange all your pieces before you begin gluing. Glue the bottom layer first. Then add the next layer and finally the top.
