

Make a Mosque or Minaret



What you need

- Three cardboard cylinders or one cut into three lengths—two x 30-cm long and one x 20-cm long (halve this if a shorter minaret is wanted)
- Stiff cardboard cut into 16-cm diameter circles
- Margarine container lids
- Half a ping-pong ball
- Strong glue
- White paint.

What to do

- Cut a circle out of a margarine lid, making the diameter larger than the diameter of the cardboard rolls.
- 2) Glue the two larger cylinders onto the lid, one on top, one underneath.
- 3) Cut four arch shapes from the shortest cylinder.
- 4) Bend the ends of the arches slightly so that this cylinder can be glued onto the circle of card.
- 5) Glue this top section onto the rest of the minaret.
- 6) Cut out a circle slightly larger in diameter than the top section and glue this on.
- 7) Glue the half ping-pong ball onto the very top of the minaret.
- 8) Paint the minaret white.
