




Make a Shooting Star Ornament



What you need:

- ◆ Small piece of thick paper, cardboard, felt or other flexible, easy-to-cut material—one or two colours
- ◆ Scissors
- ◆ Pencil
- ◆ Glue
- ◆ Thread or fishing line with which to hang your ornament
- ◆ Reinforcements (optional)
- ◆ Glitter (optional)
- ◆ Markers (optional)



	<p>Cut a circle from the paper, cardboard, felt or other material. A good circle template is a coffee mug.</p>
	<p>Starting at the edge, cut a spiral going to the centre of the circle. Decorate with glitter and/or markers.</p>
	<p>Cut a small star (about 2.5 to 5 cm wide) out of the same material and make a small hole in the top to place a thread or fishing line through so you can hang up your ornament. Decorate the star with glitter and/or markers.</p>
	<p>Glue the star to the centre of the shooting star and hang in your classroom!</p>
