

Bean Bag Toss Game



Supplies:

- White tri-fold board
- Utility knife
- Meter stick
- Masking tape
- Paintbrushes
- Turquoise, red, yellow, purple, white, and black paint
- Beanbags


Directions:




1. Lay the tri-fold board flat.




2. Cut both flaps diagonally in half with a utility knife. (*For safety purposes, we recommend wearing leather gloves when using the utility knife. Never leave the utility knife where children can pick it up.*)



3. Measure 3' down from the top on both sides.
Cut off the remainder of the flaps.



4. Fold the side panels back.



5. Cut two 2' wide rectangles out of cardboard.
Tape both ends to the two triangles, creating
an A-frame. Stand it upright.

6. Paint a T-rex head and background on the A-frame.

7. Cut out the T-rex mouth with a utility knife.
