

# Dinosaur Jug




## Supplies:


- Milk jug
- Green and brown spray paint
- 8-½" x 11" white paper
- Scissors
- Pencil
- White, black, and green card stock
- Glue
- Hot glue gun and glue ticks

## Directions:

1. Spray paint a milk jug light green and brown. Allow to dry.
2. Print the template on pg. 2 out onto 8-½" x 11" white paper. Cut out the pieces.
3. Trace two larger outer eye pieces onto the white card stock and cut out.
4. Trace two smaller pupil pieces onto the black card stock and cut out.
5. Glue the black pupil pieces to the centers of the outer white eye pieces.
6. Glue the completed eyes onto each side of the milk jug, opposite of the handle and close to the edge.
7. Trace two nostrils onto the black card stock and cut out.
8. Glue the nostrils to the center of the jug, underneath the eyes.
9. Trace the mouth onto the black card stock and cut out.
10. Trace 21 teeth onto the white card stock and cut out.
11. Glue the teeth to the mouth and glue the completed mouth along the bottom front of jug.
12. Trace spikes onto green card stock, adding a dotted lines as shown, and cut out.
13. Fold along the dotted lines on the bottom of each spike. Glue the spike edges together, forming pyramids.
14. Hot glue a row of completed spikes down the dinosaur's head.




Outer eye




Pupil




Nostril
