About our translators

PĀNIA PAPA (Ngāti Korokī-Kahukura and Ngāti Mahuta) is not a native speaker of te reo Māori. However, after beginning her journey in te reo at intermediate school, her passion for the language has led to her becoming a sought-after Māori language consultant, TV presenter, translator and editor. Pānia is CEO of the Kotahi Rau Pukapuka Charitable Trust, whose goal is to produce 100 great books for teens and adult readers in te reo Māori.

NGAERE ROBERTS (Ngāti Porou) grew up speaking te reo Māori as her first language. As a trained teacher and later a Māori immersion lecturer at Waikato University and advisor to the Ministry of Education, Ngaere's career in education also led to her being Scholastic's most prolific—and award-winning—children's book translator.

DAME KĀTERINA TE HEIKOKO MATAIRA (Ngāti Porou) was at the forefront of the Māori language renaissance and was instrumental in introducing the Te Ataurangi programme of learning te reo. Often referred to as 'the mother of kura kaupapa Māori', Kāterina was made a Dame Companion shortly before her death in 2011.

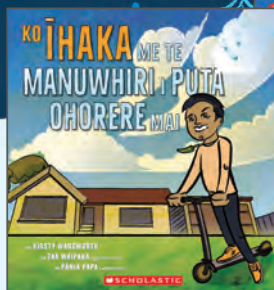
